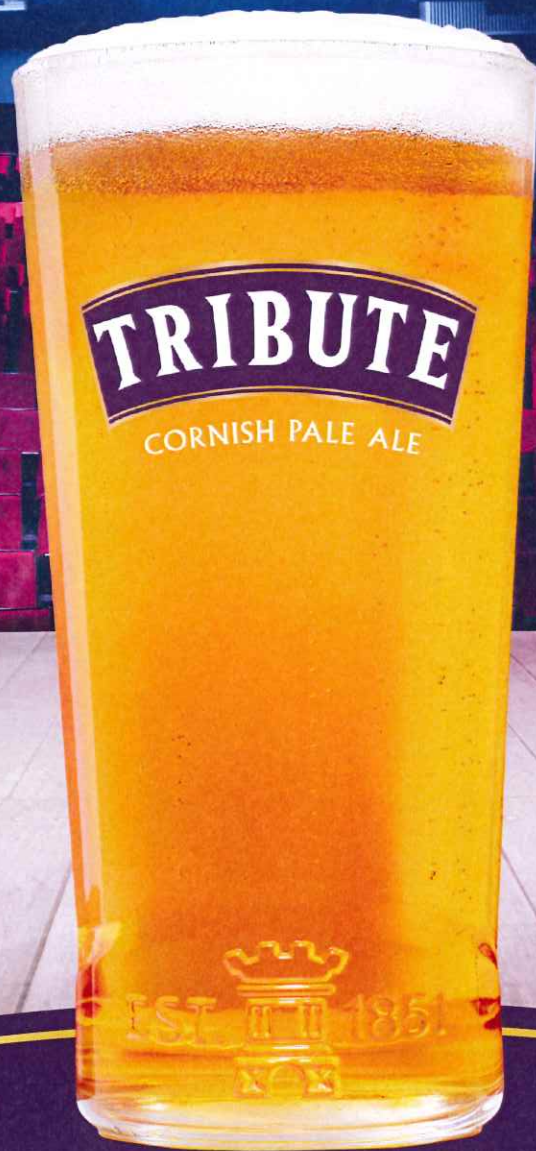

Our Story



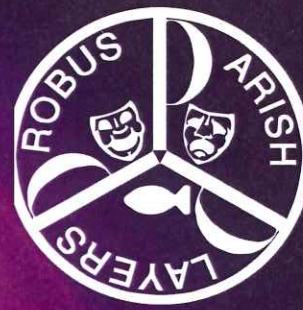
