Jeff and Jenny Townsend had the idea from St. Michaels Church in Newquay; they saw a small pantomime there and thought perhaps Probus could do it. A meeting was held at the Sanctuary, which was open to all who showed an interest, Rev Whitlock came on board in June 1991, Probus church helped with financial support to get us up and running hence the fish emblem included in our Logo. Our first pantomime was Cinderella which was performed in January in 1992, we are still putting on pantomimes to this day with a membership of approximately 60 of varying ages.

In 1993 there were great excitement and celebration as we won Calor Gas Cornwall Village Pantomime Championships for the Best Pantomime in Cornwall, this led us to be featured in Country Life Magazine and The Daily Mail Newspaper.

In 1996 we, along with the village hall committee gained financial support with a grant from Carrick Community Development scheme to enable us to build our raised seating, which now means you can see everything that is going on stage... "oh yes you can!"

In 2001 we produced Peter Pan and all the royalties from the pantomime went to Great Ormond Street Hospital at the bequest of the author J.M. Barrie. We have carried on donating to various chosen charities from any profit we make, they include Children's Hospice South West, Precious Lives Appeal and Probus Surgery just to name a few.

Pantomime is not cheap to put on but we love it so much we are continually fundraising- and without all your support we wouldn't be here today, so thank you!

We are all volunteers, love pantomime and always welcome new blood so come and join in on all the fun!
